Occasionally, a dog or cat can develop an anaphylactic reaction following a routine vaccine administration. Although such a reaction can potentially affect any pet, some breed have been known to be overrepresented amongst post-vaccine reaction cases. Such breeds include, but not limited to Chihuahuas and Dachshunds. Administering antihistamine prior to vaccination is an effective way to greatly reduce the risk of an allergic reaction.
